1. The tournament will be played to England Squash regulations, as shown on the England Squash & Racket Ball website under PLAY and RULES OF PLAY.
2. Competitors must be under the relevant age on the final day of the tournament.
3. Competitors must report to the tournament desk at least 30 minutes before their scheduled match start times. All players not reporting or unavailable to play at the appropriate time of their scheduled match start time are liable to be scratched.
4. All competitors are required to referee and mark matches when asked. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification.
5. The wearing of England approved eye protection is mandatory.
6. We reserve the right if entries are low to create mixed events for any age group.
7. The organisers, sponsors or the club are not under any liability whatsoever in respect of personal injury, loss or damage that may be sustained during the tournament.
8. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded once the draw has taken place.
